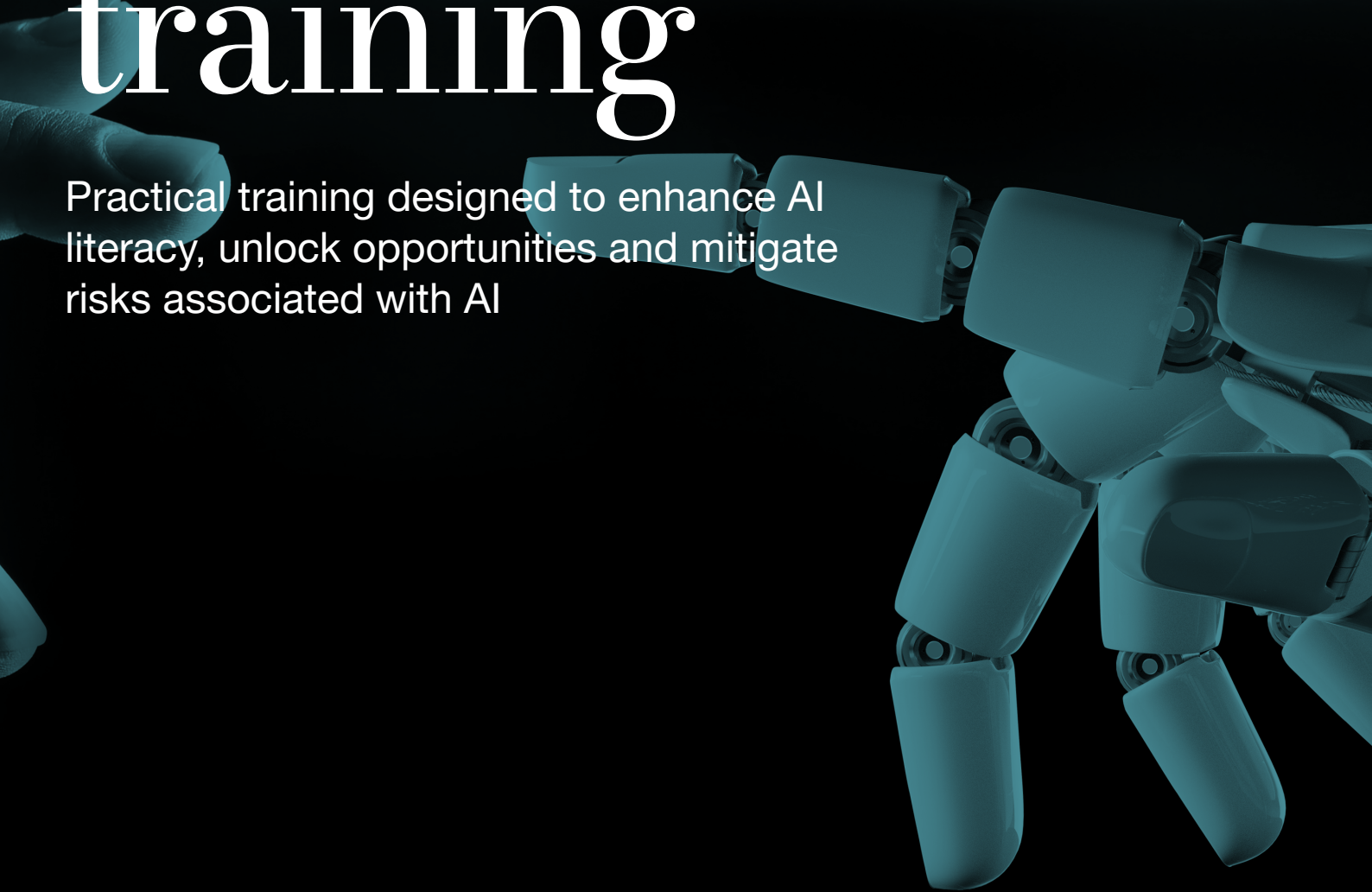

AI literacy training

During the training session, we will explore:

What is AI literacy?

- The definition and importance of AI literacy as per the EU AI Act.

What is the obligation and to whom does it apply?

- Implementing measures to ensure a sufficient level of AI literacy of staff and other persons dealing with the operation and use of AI systems on your behalf.
- Persons under the organisational remit (e.g. employees, contractors, service providers).

How can you comply?

- Measures to be applied during the use of AI systems to ensure optimal performance and compliance.
- Protocols and guidelines for safe and effective use of AI technologies.

Examples of AI literacy compliance

- Role of the European Artificial Intelligence Board in promoting AI literacy.
- Development of voluntary codes of conduct to enhance AI literacy.

What are the AI literacy requirements?

- General understanding of AI within organisations.
- Roles of providers and deployers of AI systems.
- Risk assessment and mitigation strategies for AI systems.
