


Figure 2: Age








Figure 6: Those who consider their day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months





Figure 8: Sexual Orientation




Figure 13: Those who are the primary carer for a child under 18




Figure 14: Those who are a carer for someone with long term physical or mental ill health caused by disability or age (not in paid capacity)




Figure 10: Qualification of parents




Figure 12: Parental occupation


